1. Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to set forth the guidelines for the fuel oil transfer and treatment as required in the ISM system.

2. Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the Chief Engineer to issue directions and maintain guidelines for the fuel oil system.

3. General

The operation of the fuel oil transfer and service system along with the treatment of this system is contained in the "Fuel Oil Fill and Transfer Manual" and the "Engineer's Operating Manual". Copies of these manuals are maintained in the ECR.

Additional information is contained in the Shipboard Oil Pollution Emergency Plan (SOPEP). This document is maintained in the Chief Engineer's stateroom.

4. Fuel Oil Sample

A representative sample shall be taken of the fuel that is delivered to the vessel. This sample is to be sealed, dated and signed by the supplier's representative and the master or officer in charge of the bunkering operation on completion of bunkering operations and retained under the ship's control until the fuel is substantially consumed, for a period of not less than 12 months from time of delivery.
