

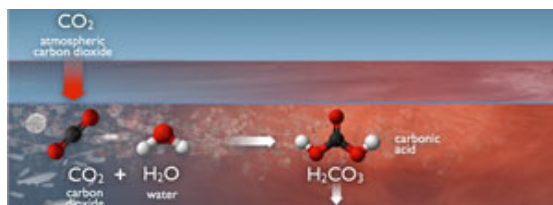
OCB-OA: FAQs about ocean acidification

The U.S. Ocean Carbon and Biogeochemistry ([OCB](#)) program, with support from the UK Ocean Acidification Research Programme ([UKOA](#)), has updated and expanded a list of frequently asked questions (FAQs) developed in 2010 by OCB, the European Project on Ocean Acidification (EPOCA), and UKOA. The FAQ is a concise, readable summary of the state of ocean acidification knowledge. For an even briefer overview, check out the 2013 factsheet titled "20 Facts about ocean acidification" below!
