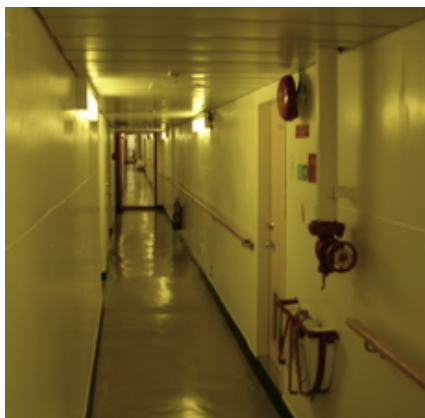
It's really easy to get lost on the *Louis*!



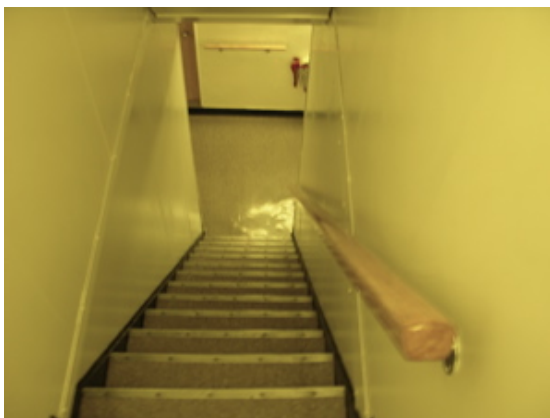
200 deck, looking starboard



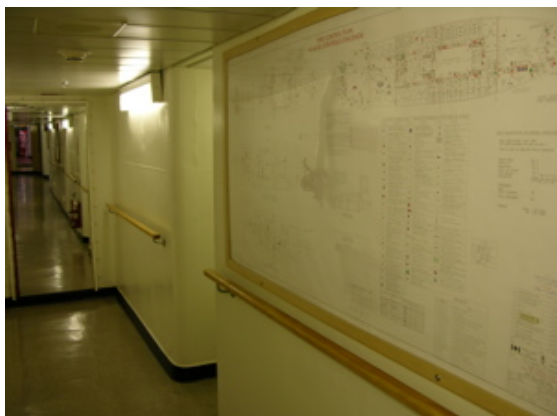
300 deck, port side, looking aft.
