

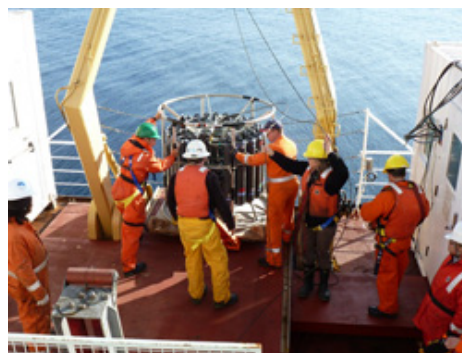
Beaufort Gyre Exploration Project: Dispatch 4: Smooth sailing

The good weather has returned and we woke today to find that the wind has backed and the seas are calm. We arrived on station this morning and began taking measurements: the rosette made its first cast down to 650 meters, the turbulence instrument - a Rockland Scientific, Inc.
