

International Committee: Frequently asked Questions

Q. How do I get my laptop set up at WHOI for internet access?

A. If you have a WHOI email account, you can set it up yourself. Otherwise you will need to ask a colleague, who has a WHOI email account, to help you. Plug in your ethernet cable. Open a browser and enter netreg.who.edu in the address bar. Follow the onscreen instructions. If you would like assistance please contact the CIS helpdesk at helpdesk@who.edu
