The Symposium will be held in Long Beach, California aboard the retired ocean liner, The Queen Mary, which is permanently docked in Long Beach, California. The Queen Mary sailed in the North Atlantic Ocean from 1936-1967 and then was retired from service. The Queen Mary is currently a historic landmark (listed on the National Register of Historic Places) that features restaurants, a museum and a 346 room hotel with conference facilities.
