

Correction to “Coupled ocean-atmosphere model response to freshwater input: Comparison to Younger Dryas event” by Syukuro Manabe and Ronald J. Stouffer

In the paper “Coupled ocean-atmosphere model response to freshwater input: Comparison to Younger Dryas event” by Syukuro Manabe and Ronald J. Stouffer (*Paleoceanography*, 12 (2), 321-336, 1997), the latitudinal labels on Figures 13a and 13b are incorrect. Latitudes 90N and 90S should be replaced by 90S and 90N, respectively.

The Figure 15 caption states incorrectly that the times series of THC (thermohaline circulation) is obtained from the FWN (Freshwater Experiment North). It is actually obtained from FWS (Freshwater Experiment South).

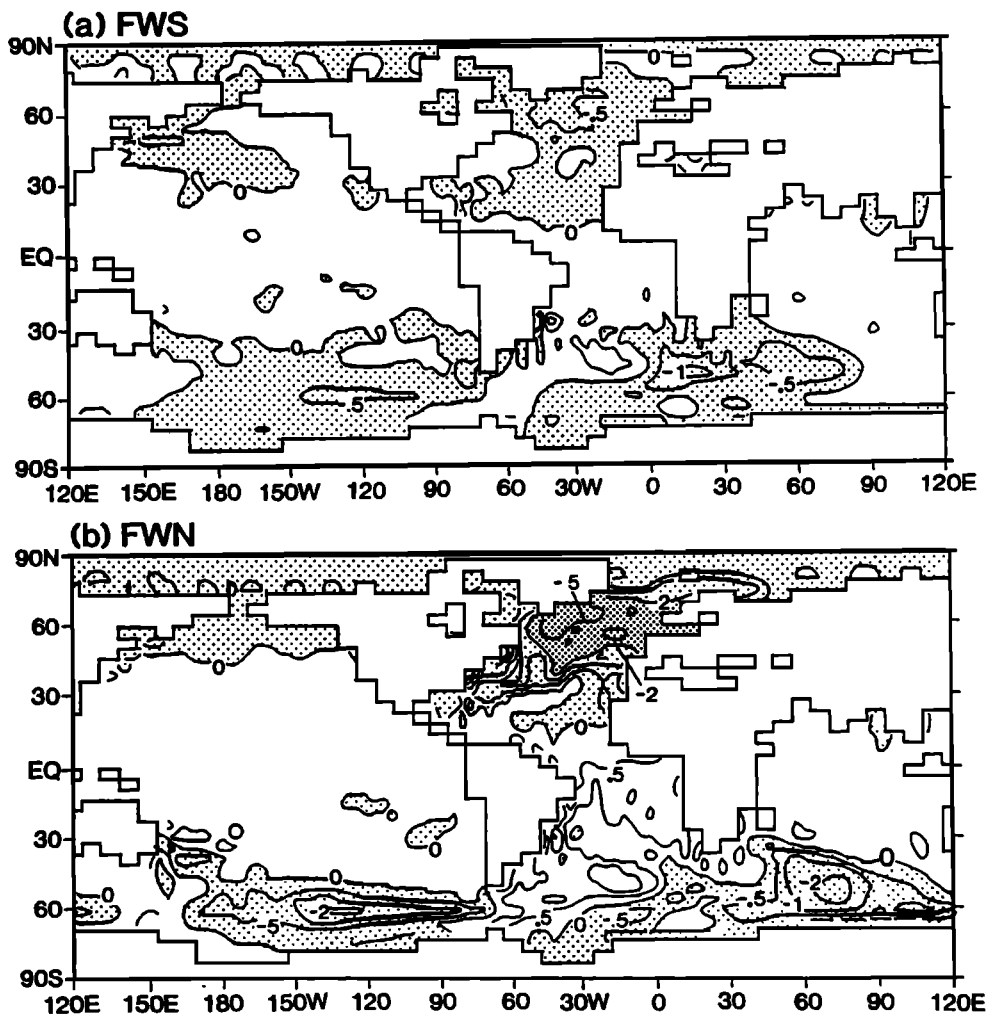


Figure 16. Geographical distributions of SST anomaly ($^{\circ}\text{C}$) averaged over the 401st-500th year of (a) FWS. (b) FWN. Here anomalies are defined as the difference between FW and control experiments. Contours are drawn in logarithmic intervals at 0, ± 0.5 , ± 1 , and ± 2 .

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

Figure 16 was published with the wrong caption. Figure 16 and its correct caption are shown below.
