
Arctic Observing Network (AON) Davis Strait: R/V Atlantis, September 2015


The charts below depict mooring locations and CTD sites that will be occupied during this cruise. Mooring north of 68°N were serviced as part of a collaboration with the Greenland Institute of Natural Resources, and will be visited if our colleagues at GINR request assistance. Order of occupation depends on weather and other operational factors, and the exact cruise track is thus defined day-to-day during the actual cruise.

Mooring Sites



Blue squares and magenta circles mark the locations of the Davis Strait mooring array. Magenta squares in the northern portion of the chart mark the positions of Greenland Institute of Natural Resources moorings that will be deployed as part of this cruise.

CTD Stations



Black circles mark the locations of CTD stations that have been routinely occupied since 2004. Time permitting, we intend to sample these station as part of the 2011 cruise.
