## Recycling Guidelines

You can now recycle all of your paper, bottles & cans, and cardboard in the same recycling bin!

### RECYCLE



White & colored office paper,  
Newspapers,  
Magazines & catalogues,  
Junk mail,  
Post-it notes,  
Envelopes with windows,  
Cereal (chipboard) boxes,  
Books,  
Brown paper bags,  
Telephone books,

***Staples and paperclips  
are OK***

Aluminum cans,  
Tin cans,  
Bi-metal cans,  
Plastic (1-7)  
Glass bottles and jars, &  
Juice Boxes

Please flatten cardboard & place next to large blue recycling bins.  
Place boxes or plastic bags of styrofoam peanuts or other packing materials at your mail stop, for pick up by Distribution.

Styrofoam,  
Fuel containers,  
Plastic films or bags,  
Needles
