

OAO Announces New Ignition Grant Program

The purpose of this award is to provide funding as a means to bring an idea, invention, or innovation to an initial demonstrable stage so as to position it for additional commercial development. As examples, funds may be used to build or advance a prototype, demonstrate a proof of concept, isolate or elucidate a potentially useful chemical structure, or develop an improved culturing protocol for a commercially valuable organism. The value and protection of intellectual property should be a consideration. These awards are only available to members of the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution's Scientific and Technical Staffs. There is \$150,000 available to be awarded this year, divided into three awards of approximately \$50,000 each. Due date: **FRIDAY DECEMBER 21, 2012**


