Introduction

 The WHOI Committee on Work and Family Life is pleased to publish this listing of child care and other family resources. It has two predecessors. The first was a notebook compiled by members of the The Federal Women's Program at the Northeast Fisheries Center of the National Marine Fisheries Service. Karen Foster and Susan Shepherd visited child care facilities and provided information on them for several years. In 1990, Falmouth Early Childhood Consultant Davien Gould compiled a limited edition of an "Early Childhood Resource Directory" with a grant from the Massachusetts Department of Education in conjunction with the Mashpee Public Schools. This booklet is based on Davien Gould's work, and the Committee thanks her for providing both her files and continuing advice.

The resources of Falmouth and neighboring towns are addressed here. No judgements are provided, only information; parents are encouraged to talk with other parents who have used the facilities as they seek child care. They may also find helpful the notes on page 4 under the title "Pursuing the Ideal Child Care Situation."

In addition to the centers on this list, which was updated in the summer of 1991, there are many fine home day-care providers. It would be very difficult to make a complete listing of these, and we encourage those seeking both center and home day care to contact the Child Care Works (1-800-338-1717) and the Child Care Resource Network of Cape Cod & the Islands (1-800-649-4086) for help and current information.

An issue that surfaces frequently with working parents is that of day care for a sick dependent, "emergency care." Our assessment is that there is little available other than the network of friends and family that parents or those with elderly dependents establish for themselves. However, the Visiting Nursing Association (VNA) can provide coverage with very little notice. The Mature Sitters (548-3443) may also be able to assist in these situations; a family must first be registered with them, and they usually require some notice. While these are expensive options, they do at least provide a service that may allow you to give that talk scheduled six months ago....

Distribution of this booklet is planned to include interested employees of the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution, the Northeast Fisheries Center of the National Marine Fisheries Service in Woods Hole, and the Woods Hole, Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket Steamship Authority. The Committee hopes this will be a useful resource for area families and would welcome suggestions for improvements to future editions.

Pursuing the Ideal Day-Care Situation

Resources

- Check local newspaper listings, advertisements.
- Check the "Yellow Pages" (not to forget government listings for such things as the Office for Children, which will give you the guidelines and laws governing accredited day care).
- Consult your local public librarian for resource materials including area day-care listings.
- Consult your Personnel or Human Resources Department. Some employers provide listings such as this one.
- Ask around and get recommendations from friends and family.
- Select a few accredited sites and visit. The centers and providers are usually very receptive to visits.

Some Considerations

- Do you want a program or do you prefer home day care? Is a cooperative feasible?
- Is this a year-round, full-time operation or must alternative day care be arranged at certain times? If so, are recommendations made?
- Do the hours of operation suit your needs?
- Is the day care conveniently located?
- Is the child's age appropriate to the day-care situation?
- Infant care can be particularly difficult to find. If possible, start early and persevere!
- If disparate age groups are covered, how are the different groups managed?
- Are age groups separated—at all? sometimes?
- If applicable, how are large groups managed—two-plus staff to large groups or multiple small groups?
- What credentials do staff have? What is the staff turnover?

- Are the credentials (and those of the facility) renewed, monitored, and updated?
- What is the "curriculum," the philosophy?
- Are the age-appropriate skills addressed and reinforced?
- Are there projects and activities? Are they geared to a theme?
- Do older children go on field trips? How are they transported?
- What is the dietary philosophy? Meal and snack schedule?
- What is the nap/rest time policy?
- Where do the children sleep? Is it comfortable and quiet?
- What is the sick-child policy?
- What are the behavioral standards and expectations and how are they approached?
- Consider toilet training policies.
- How does provider handle "stages" (such as difficult separation) or situations (such as hitting)?
- Is the physical plant fun, challenging, and safe?
- Are plugs, sharp objects, medicines, etc. made inaccessible to children?
- Are there smoke alarms, fire drills?
- How is an emergency situation handled?
- Is the facility clean without appearing unyielding to dirt and the mess children will make?
- What reporting mechanism is used to communicate with parents?

In the final analysis, you and your child must feel comfortable with whatever arrangement you choose. You will want your child nurtured and directed in ways that agree with your values. Day care is best when convenient to your needs, affordable, and a happy situation for all concerned.

Cape Cod Child Development Program Head Start

**Centers are located in the towns of Mashpee, Bourne,
Centerville, Osterville, and Falmouth**

Head Start is based on the idea that parents are the most important educators of their children and have the greatest influence on their lives. Two types of programs are available to provide a comprehensive child development program that serves families with children one to two years under kindergarten age.

Home-Based Program

In an exciting, innovative preschool program, a home visitor sees the family once a week in their home to explore new ways for the parent or guardian to teach the child and to share information about health, nutrition, community resources, and parent activities. Two to three times a month, the home-based children come together at the center for a typical preschool classroom experience. Parents who choose this program find it a positive preschool experience that puts them in the forefront of their child's education, offers individualization, and provides information and services to the entire family.

Center-Based Program

A traditional preschool provides a group experience for the young child. Sixteen to twenty children come together for four days a week at the center. The program is designed specifically to meet the needs of the children enrolled in the group. Parents are encouraged to join the staff in planning, implementing, and enriching the Head Start program by volunteering in the classroom, making materials, participating in meetings and workshops, etc.

Services provided by the Head Start Program include: education, parent involvement, social services, transportation, health, and nutrition. Children with special needs will have therapeutic services provided in cooperation with the local school district.

Falmouth Public Schools and School-Age Day Care

The Falmouth Public Schools are organized into four Elementary (K-4) districts: Teaticket, East Falmouth, North Falmouth, and Mullen-Hall. The rest of the grades are serviced by town-wide facilities: The Morse Pond School (5-6), Lawrence School (7-8), and Falmouth High School (9-12). Falmouth High School also serves the Town of Mashpee. School commences the Thursday after Labor Day and runs until late June. There are three week-long recesses: from Christmas to New Year's Day, in late February, and in mid-April.

The Falmouth School System's daily sessions are as follows:

Kindergarten (A.M.)	9:10 - 11:40
Kindergarten (P.M.)	12:40 - 3:10
Elementary	9:10 - 3:10
Morse Pond	8:30 - 2:40
Lawrence	8:20 - 2:30
High School	7:50 - 2:00

Entry requirements include an original birth certificate or passport, complete immunization record, physical (within 9 months), and transcript from prior school. Kindergartners must be five years of age by December 31st of the current year.

School-Age Day Care

Options for after school day care of school-age children vary slightly among the four elementary districts. Children can ride an alternate school bus to a sitter or a home day care within each district. In addition, Mullen-Hall and Teaticket have an inexpensive latch-key program after school. These programs provide no alternative service on school holidays. Cape Cod Child Development operates another program at the Mullen-Hall School and provides transportation from the East Falmouth and Teaticket Schools. This is a year-round program designed to accommodate the working parent. Fees for this program are on a sliding scale and participating families cannot exceed an income limit.

There are several options for private day care. Four licensed private daycares service the Mullen-Hall district. Sandpiper Nursery (Gifford St.) offers after-school programs but provides no services for school holidays. Little Red Schoolhouse (Locustfield Rd.) also provides a structured after-school kindergarten and supervised play for first graders. Children ride the bus to the program. Care is available during the public school holidays. The VNA Child Care Center (Ter Heun Dr.) also operates a private kindergarten surround program that is serviced by the Mullen-Hall buses. There is year-round coverage for school vacations. The Woods Hole Daycare Cooperative (Memorial Dr.) is also available by school bus and provides for school holidays.

Magic Years Daycare (Trotting Park Rd.) is serviced by buses from Teaticket School. Coverage during school holidays is available at Magic Years.

Buses from North Falmouth School can deliver children to Little Kids (Rt. 28A). This program is also available during school holidays.
