



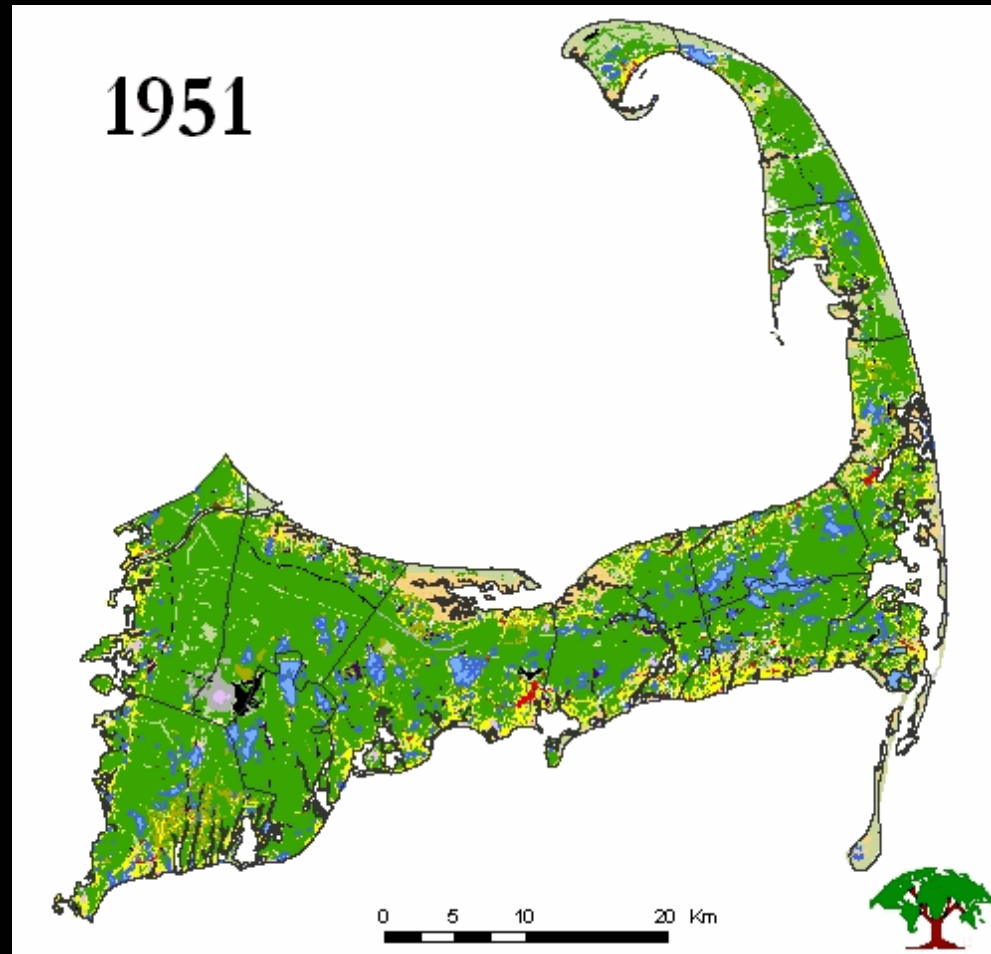

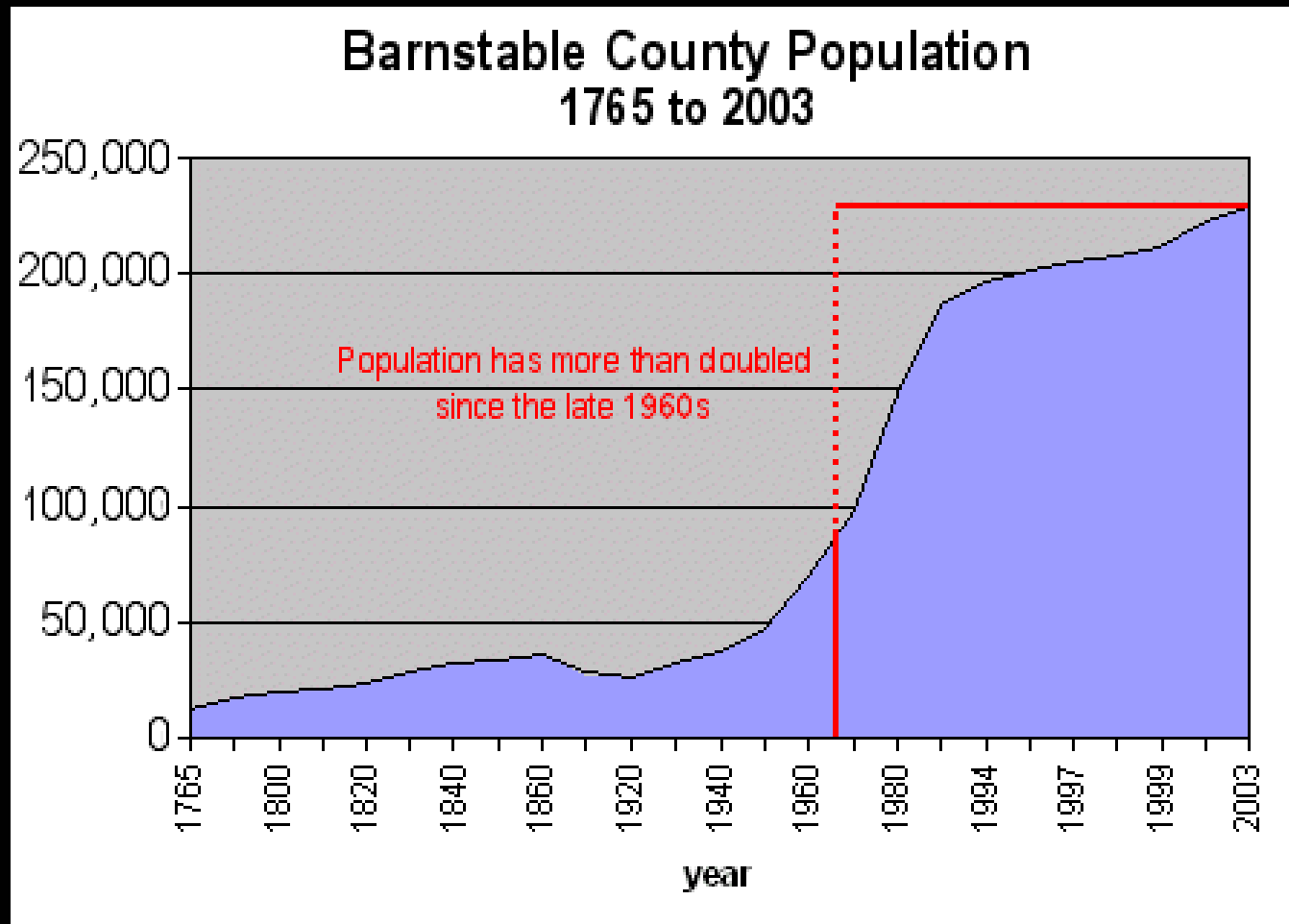

Population Changes on Cape Cod



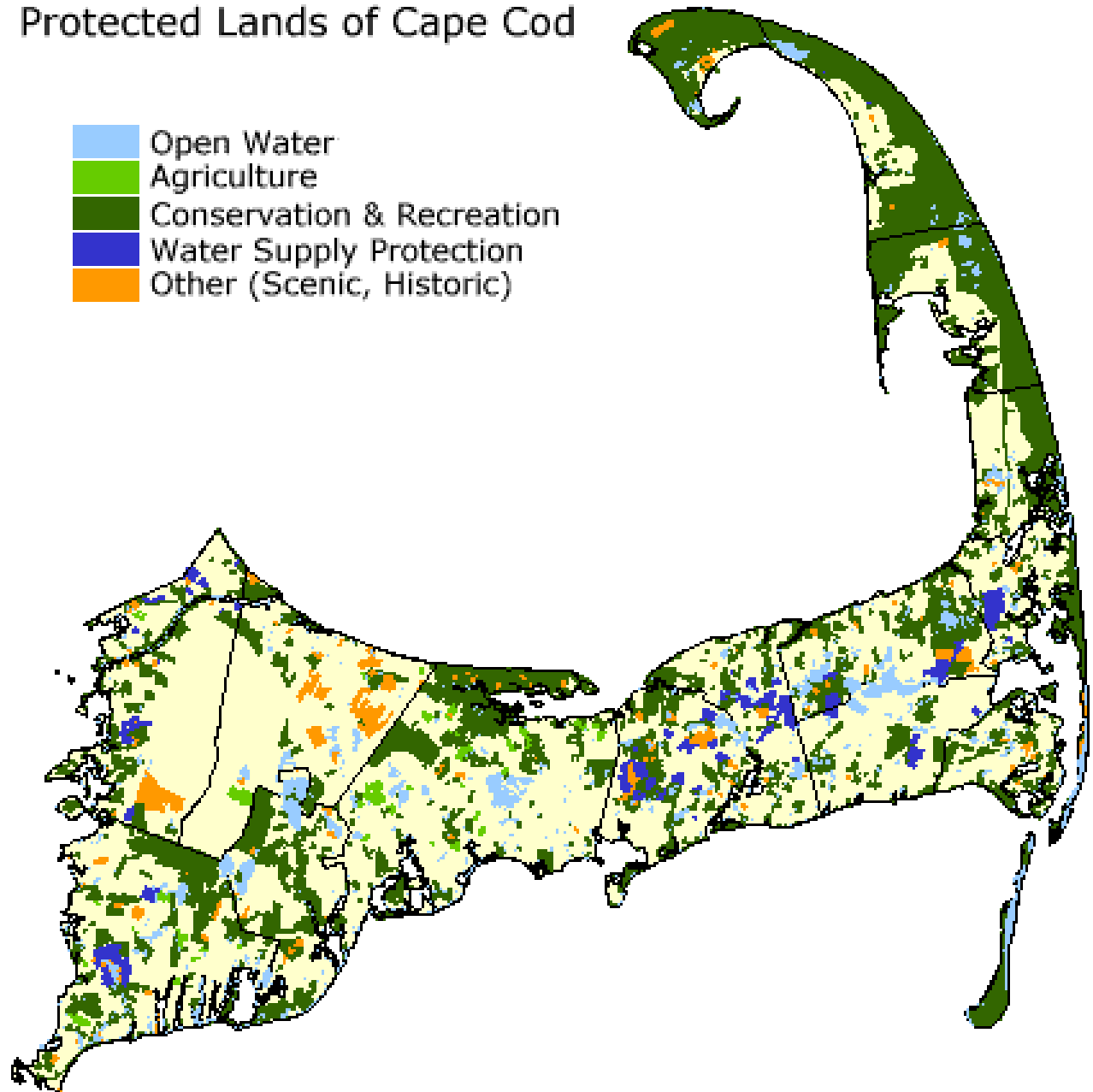

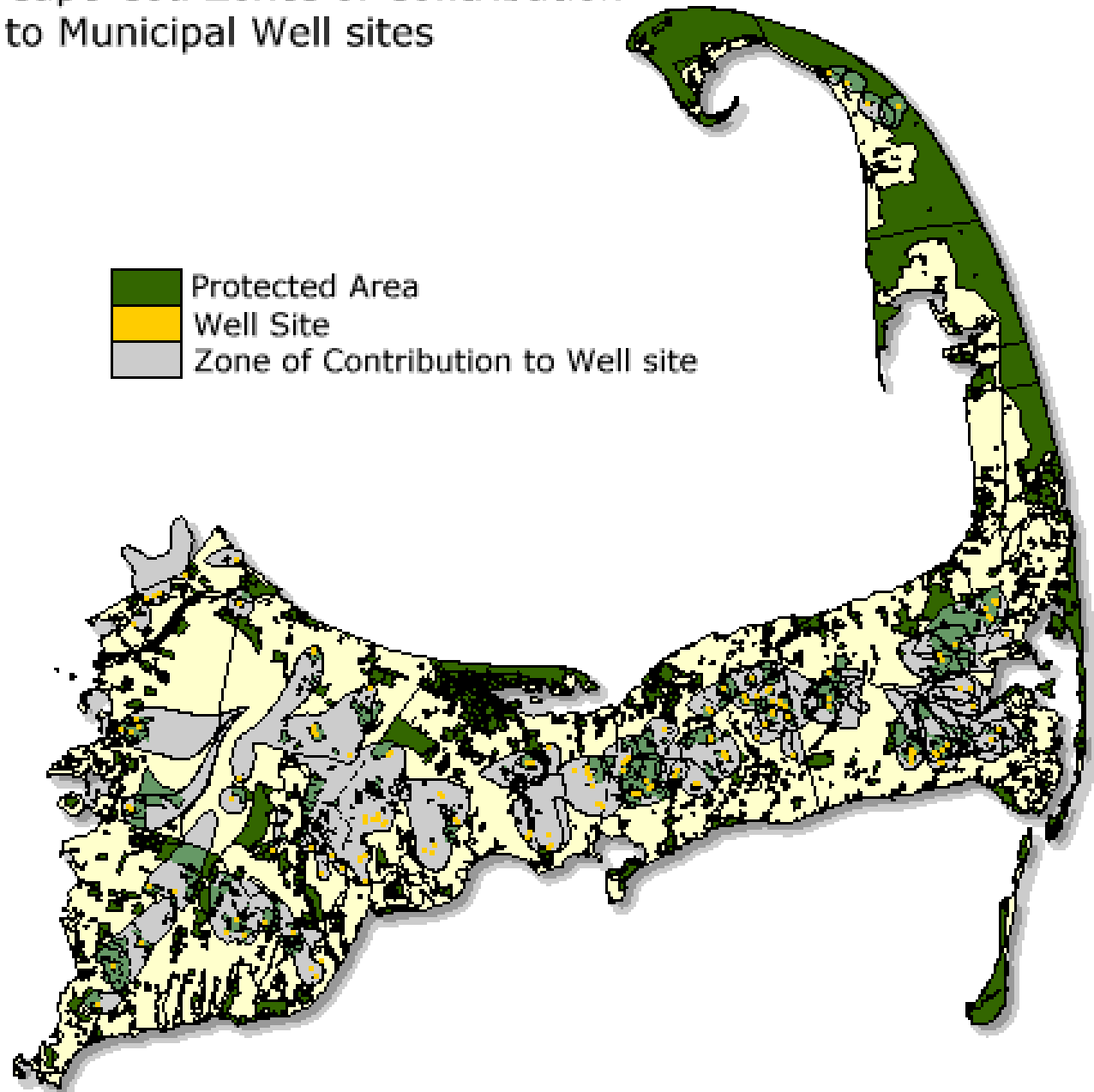

to Municipal Well sites

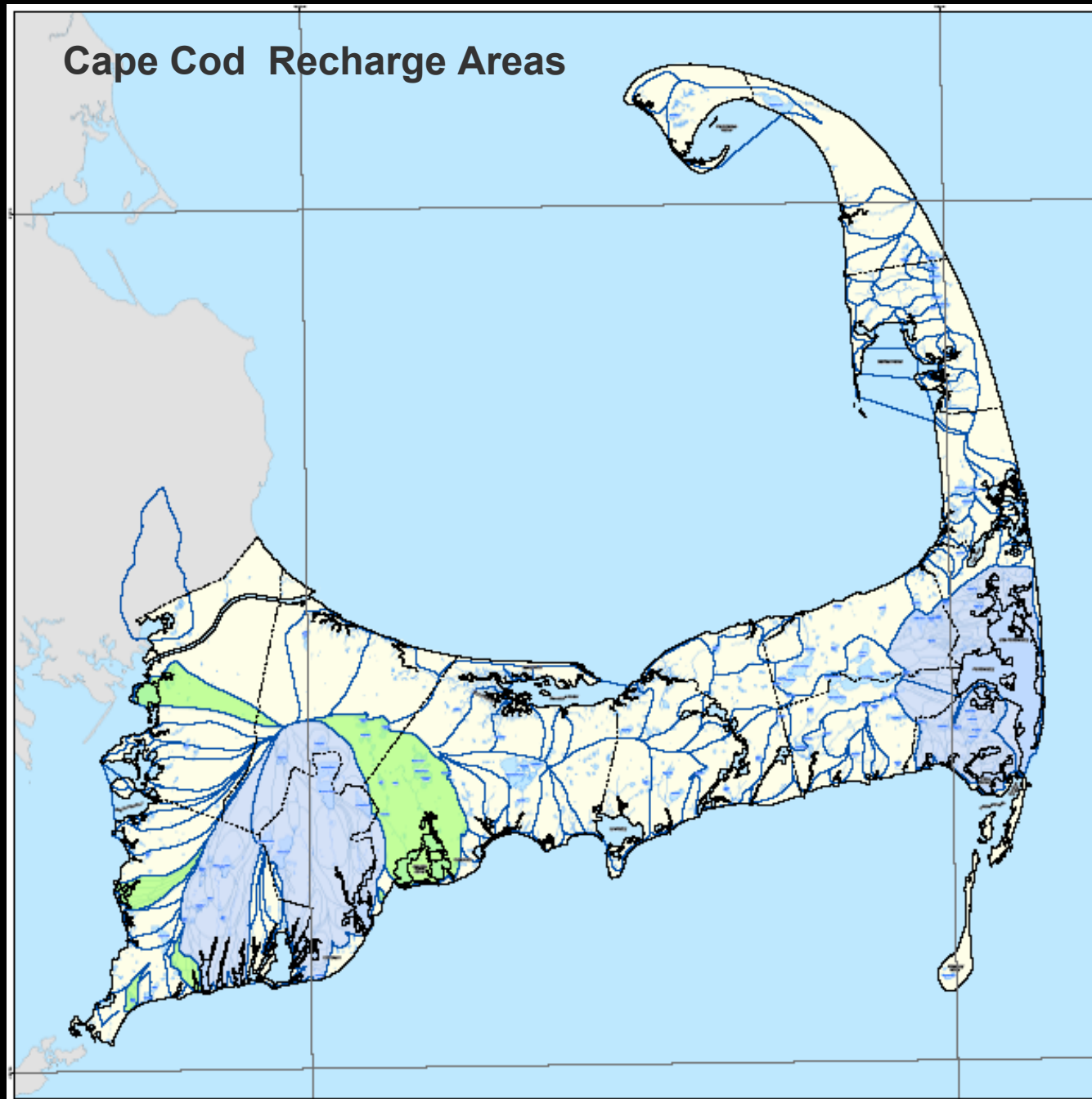

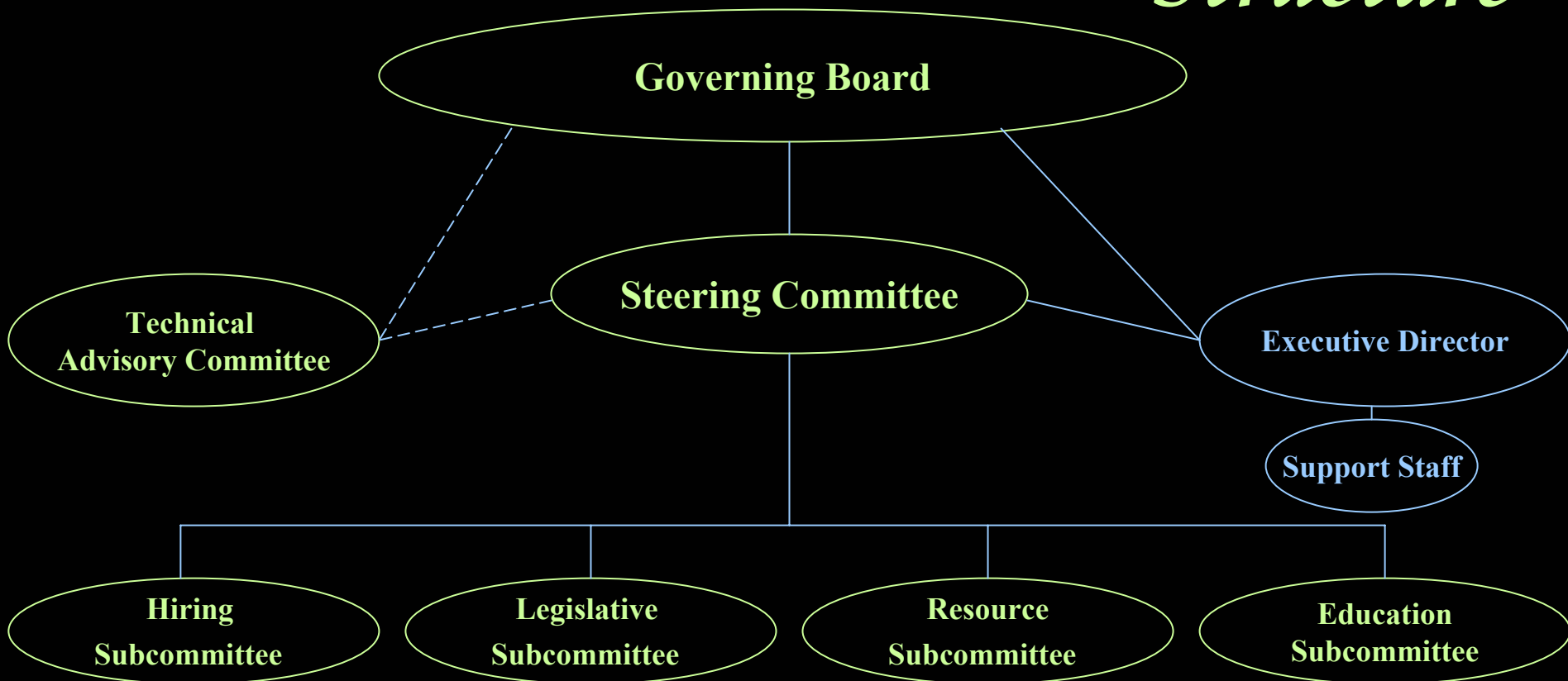

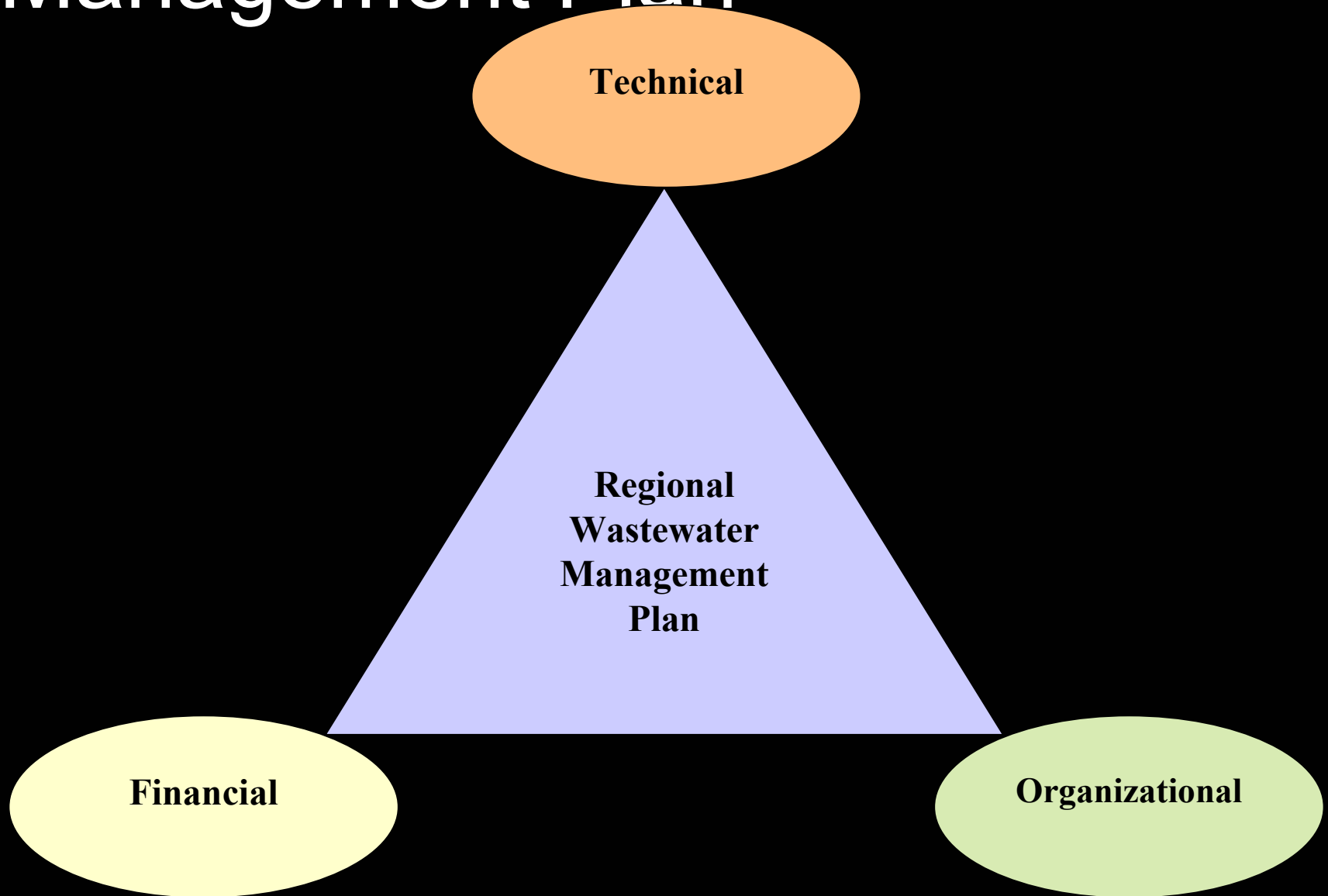
