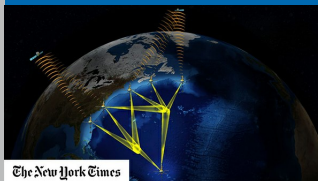
## Wave Glider provides gateway to remote exploration
