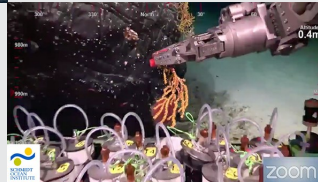


Scientists discover iceberg routes from Canada to Florida
